

# Kunming University Explanation of Average Credit Grade Point

(This grade point explanation applies to students who graduated in the year 2023.)

## I. Correspondence between Grades and Credit Grade Points

The course Average Grade Point (GPA) is the fundamental basis and an important indicator for measuring the quality of a student's academic performance and for evaluating academic excellence. The Average Grade Point (GPA) adopts a 4.0 grading scale. The calculation formula and the corresponding relationship are as follows:

Course Credit Grade Point = Course Grade Point × Course Credits

Course Average Credit Grade Point (GPA) =  $\Sigma$  (Course Credit Grade Point × Course Credits) /  $\Sigma$  Course Credits

The correspondence between grades and grade point values is as follows:
