

Kunming University Explanation of Average Credit Grade Point

(This grade point explanation applies to students who graduated in or before the year 2022.)

I. Correspondence between Grades and Credit Grade Points

The course Average Grade Point (GPA) is the fundamental basis and an important indicator for measuring the quality of a student's academic performance and for evaluating academic excellence. The Average Grade Point (GPA) adopts a 4.0 grading scale. The calculation formula and the corresponding relationship are as follows:

Course Credit Grade Point = Course Grade Point × Course Credits

Course Average Credit Grade Point (GPA) = Σ (Course Credit Grade Point × Course Credits) / Σ Course Credits

The correspondence between grades and grade point values is as follows:
