

Kunming University Explanation of Average Credit Grade Point

(This explanation applies to students graduating in 2024 and later)

I. Correspondence between Grades and Credit Grade Points

The course Average Credit Grade Point (GPA) is the basis and an important indicator for measuring students' academic quality and for assessment and excellence selection. The course Average Grade Point (GPA) adopts a 5-point grading scale. The calculation formula and the corresponding relationship are as follows:

- Course Credit Grade Point = (Course Grade / 10) - 5
- Course Credit Points = Course Credit Grade Point × Course Credits
= [(Course Grade / 10) - 5] × Course Credits
- Course Average Credit Grade Point (GPA) = Σ (Course Credit Grade Point × Course Credits) / Σ Course Credits

The correspondence between grades and grade point values is as follows:

Score Range	100-90	89-80	79-70	69-60	<60
Percentage Scale	5.0-4.0	3.9-3.0	2.9-2.0	1.9-1.0	0
Descriptive Grades	Excellent	Good	Fair	Pass	Fail
Grade Point	4.5	3.5	2.5	1.5	0

II. Other Notes

The credit grade point for an exempted course is recorded as 1. The average credit grade point is rounded to two decimal places.
